I am writing to re-nominate Professor Richard Falk for the 2017 Nobel Peace Prize. I nominated Professor Falk first in 2016 and others have annually nominated him for the Nobel Peace Prize since 2008. I will attach here my letter submitted on his behalf last year. In addition, I would like to add a bio sketch that touches on some of his most recent contributions:

Since 2002 Professor Falk has been associated with the Orfalea Center of Global and International Studies at the University of California, Santa Barbara. His recent books are (Re)Imagining Humane Global Governance (2014), Humanitarian Intervention and Legitimacy Wars (2014) Palestine: The Legitimacy of Hope (2014), Chaos and Counterrevolution: After the ArabSpring (2015) and Power Shift: On the New Global Order (2016). Between 2008 and 2014 he held the position of UN Special Rapporteur on Human Rights in Occupied Palestine. He currently directs at UCSB a project on Climate Change, Human Security, and Democracy, serves as Senior Vice President of the Nuclear Age Peace Foundation, and is a member of the Editorial Advisory Board of The Nation and Third World Quarterly.
